Of course, pom-poms aren't the only trend we're following at the shop. # Fall Classes

If you're plugged into the online knitting world, chances are you're familiar with designer & blogger Jared Flood of Brooklyntweed fame. Now he's teamed up with *Classic Elite* to publish his first design collection, **MADE IN BROOKLYN**, and the results are gorgeous. Of course we want to make one of everything, so we had to add a couple of new *Classic Elite* yarns (darn!). Worsted weight **Portland Tweed** blends wool, alpaca and viscose in an understated color palette that's perfectly suited to our City of Roses. (I've just started Jared's HURON sweater for John and I \*love\* this yarn!). We're also scheduled to receive **Fresco**, a fine gauge blend of wool and alpaca with a dash of angora for a heavenly halo. Weeeee!

Our longstanding infatuation with *Rowan* continues, and this season we're especially excited about **Lima**.

Instead of the usual twist, this buttery soft alpaca has been woven into a chainette for maximum loft. The color palette is heathery and sophisticated. Each ball just begs to be petted! **Lima** would be wonderful in a simple scarf, or go all out and try one of the gorgeous sweaters from the *Lima Design Collection*. Kaffe Fassett's **Colourscape Chunky** was a huge hit at the Bee last season (remember the Big Button Hats?) and we're happy to see it back again with double the colors and a fun collection of new designs. We've also added lots more colors of **Cocoon!**

Bulky knits are BIG again this fall and creative visionary Teva Durham of *Loop-D-Loop* fame brings us **Granite**, a plush wool roving that's seamed down the center for great stitch definition. It's very different, and very cool. And while we're talking about yarns for instant gratification, look for *Berroco* **Sundae**, a heathery soft bulky yarn for almost overnight sweaters, hats and wraps.

If a classic Donegal is more your speed, be sure to check out **Plymouth Tweed**, a worsted virgin lambswool with a slight twist and brilliantly coordinated color flecks. Trust me, the colors are amazing! This is a timeless wooly tweed, perfect for heirloom sweaters and hard-wearing accessories.

And for those of you who are looking for something *not so* wooly (but still classic in appearance), we'd like you to meet **Vintage Wool**. This

high quality wool and acrylic blend from *Berroco* is silky soft, machine washable, inexpensive and yet still feels good in your hands (really, it passed all of our swatch tests!).

In the Notions Department, we've added a small selection of square (yes, *square*) double pointed and circular knitting needles from *Kollage*. Designed to be more ergonomic on your hands by decreasing stress and strain, these needles also produce super-uniform stitches. Isn't it fun to try something different?!

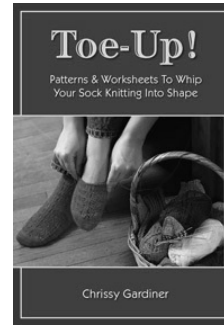

Her designs have also appeared in *Interweave KNITS* magazine, *Vogue Knitting* magazine and *knitty.com*.

### Autumn in Oregon Socks with Christina Peters

These gorgeous socks designed by Chrissy Gardiner were inspired by falling leaves and rainy days (you can't get more Oregonian than that!). The leafy cuff is knit flat and sewn into a ring, then the cuff stitches are picked up and knit downward. More unique stitch patterns decorate the leg. The perfect project for all of you adventurous sock knitters out there!

## BACK TO BASICS

### Techniques with Tess with Tess Mattos

*Increase your knitting IQ! Take one or all three of these skills tutorials. You can't go wrong!*

Class fee: \$25.00 for one, \$40.00 for two, \$55.00 for three.

#### • Picking up Stitches – Tuesday 10/20, 6:00pm – 8:00pm

Did you know that there's a difference between "picking up" and "picking up and knitting" stitches? In this tutorial we'll explore which technique to use when, where to insert the needle so that holes are minimized, how many stitches to pick up, stitch ratios, picking up on straight versus curved edges, and more. Please bring homework swatch.

#### • Buttonholes – Tuesday 10/27, 6:00pm – 8:00pm

Not all buttonholes are created equal! We'll discuss placement and choice of buttonholes and practice several different styles including simple eyelet, Japanese eyelet-style, three-row vertical, one-row horizontal, and reinforced. Please bring homework swatch.

#### • Totally Tubular – Tuesday 11/10, 6:00pm – 8:00pm

Curious about magic loop or knitting in the round with two circulars at once? In this tutorial we'll explore newer methods of knitting small circumferences that don't require the use of double pointed needles. These are great techniques for socks, fingerless gloves or mittens, tops of hats and more.

### Gilding the Lily with Christina Peters

Finished binding off? That's when the fun begins! Let your creativity shine with a little simple embellishment. Christina will show you a few basic embroidery stitches, plus how to work duplicate stitch (perfect for personalizing gifts!). Class fee: \$25.00

### Continental Knitting with Tess Mattos

## Free Pattern! Hive Hat

### Materials:

- *Dream in Color Classy Paintbox*  
(5 colors, approx. 150 yds total)
- US size #8 – 16" circular and dpns
- Stitch marker

Gauge: 4 ½ sts = 1"

Size: Adult, fits most.

Tanya Patterson updated her Bee-have Stash Hat for Sock Summit and our exclusive Classy Paintbox kits. For more free patterns, including our matching Hive Mitts, visit [www.theknittingbee.com](http://www.theknittingbee.com).

### Directions:

Cast on 80 sts to the circular needle. Place marker and join for working in the round. Knit 1 round. Purl 6 rounds.

\* Change color, knit 6 rounds. Change color, purl 6 rounds.

Repeat from \* 3x more. (5 purl stripes and 4 knit stripes worked.)

*Begin shaping the crown, switching to dpns when necessary:*

Round 1: Change color, knit all stitches.

Round 2: \* Knit 8 sts, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end.

Round 3, 5 & 6: Knit all sts.

Round 4: \* Knit 7 sts, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end.

Change color, purl 6 rounds.

*Next decrease section:*

Round 1: Change color, knit all stitches.

Round 2: \* Knit 6 sts, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end.

Round 3, 5 & 6: Knit all sts.

Round 4: \* Knit 5 sts, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end.

Change color, purl 6 rounds.

*Final decrease section:*

Round 1: Change color, knit all stitches.

Round 2: \* Knit 2 sts, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end.

Round 3: Knit all sts.

Round 4: \* Knit 1 sts, k2tog. Repeat from \* to end.

Round 5 & 6: \* K2tog. Repeat from \* to end.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts. Weave in ends. Enjoy!
